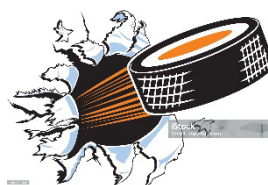

Reports of Coyotes

Island coyotes are habituated to humans, and they won't typically run off at first sight of you. They are more likely to exhibit some curiosity before slowly moving off.

If someone does have a coyote encounter, make yourself big and make noise, don't turn and run which can trigger the instinct for them to chase.

While people are not at serious risk, unattended pets are a different issue, particularly cats. A small animal alone outside at night, particularly around dusk or dawn could be taken as prey.

While a coyote passing through is not a cause for concern, animals that appear to be establishing a presence might be. In that case call fish and wildlife to discuss the situation at 902-368-4683.

Council Decisions

Council approved application 1720 for a Change of Use to allow an in-home daycare at 15 Abegweit Lane with the conditions of no on street parking and a letter to be sent to the adjoining neighbor.

Council approved the project management proposal for the boardwalk project from CBCL in the amount of \$15, 300+HST

Council agrees that the Town will provide the balance of the Town portion of financing for the Boardwalk project if the fundraising does not meet its objective by the time the project is ready to proceed

Council approved the quote for mulching the trails from Backwoods Tree Cutting Services for \$7,130.43+HST

Council approved the Town to borrow up to \$3,500,000 from Finance PEI for capital improvements and resolution of liens for the Eliyahu Wellness for a five (5) year term amortized over 20 years with an interest rate of no more than 6.65%, payments deferred to Oct 1, 2025.
