Council Decisions

- Council required the homeowner at 4 Hilltop Avenue to remove the current sign (32sqft) within 30 days and allow only a maximum 10sqft sign as per bylaw section 6.5(1)(c).
- Council appointed Josh Beaton and Joel Legault as Development Officers in addition to Derek French for the Town of North Rustico.
- Council approved commercial application 1725 for an addition to the medical Centre with the conditions outlined by the development officer.
- Council approved the first reading of Bylaw # 2024-01 North Rustico Sewer and Water Utility Corporation Bylaw be hereby approved.
- Council released the Lessons Learned Summary from MNP as a public document. Council accepted the bid from Diversified Divers in the amount of \$273,450.00 plus HST and award them contract No. 242648.00 Town of North Rustico Seawalk Boardwalk Replacement, based on the recommendation of CBCL.
