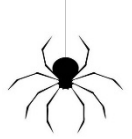

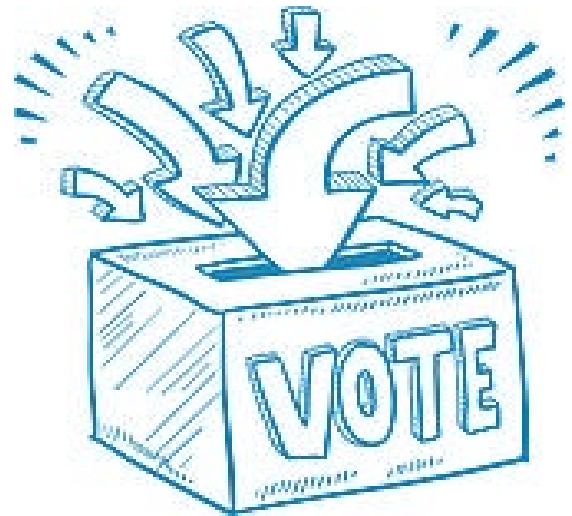

Nominations shall only be received during office hours at the election office, located at the North Rustico Town Office -106 Riverside Drive, North Rustico, PE. The election office hours shall be Monday to Friday – 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The deadline for correcting elector information shall be no later than 11:59 a.m. on Friday November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

### Emergency Measures Organization

Emergencies can be very stressful but if you take the time now to prepare, you and your family will be better able to cope. Learn how quick and easy it is to become prepared to face a range of emergencies, anytime, anywhere. You can get more information at [PrinceEdwardIsland.ca/BePrepared](http://PrinceEdwardIsland.ca/BePrepared) Reminder to change the batteries in your smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors.

**EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KIT**

- At least 2 litres of water per person per day for 3-5 days
- At least a 3-5 day supply of non-perishable food and a can opener
- Battery powered or hand-crank radio and extra batteries
- Flashlight, whistle, first aid kit, and dust mask to help filter contaminated air
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape for sheltering in place
- Moist towelettes, tissues, toilet paper, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation needs.
- Cash (small bills, ideally up to \$200)
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Printed list of contact names and phone numbers
