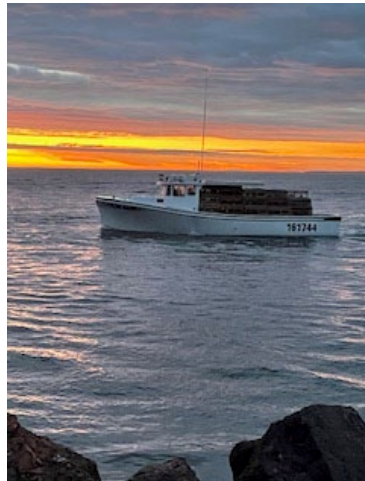
Reminder that clean-up week starts May 2nd through to May 11th. Take advantage of this free program from our town and keep our Town beautiful.

Council Decisions Feb 2025

- The Code of Conduct for members of Council Bylaw #2025-01 was read and approved a first time on Jan 6, 2025, and read, approved and formally adopted on Feb 3, 2025
- Council approved Change Order 02, addition of a 2nd spare pump for the treatment plant, under the Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrades project for of \$18,875 plus HST.
- Council approved the date to hold the by-election for Monday April 14, 2025, with the advance poll on Saturday April 5, 2025.
- Council appointed Deputy CAO Sheri Prosser Dykstra as MEO and CAO Stephanie Moase as Deputy MEO for the by-election.
- Council approved the change order to increase the MNP contract by \$26,000.
- Council approved the public meeting to be held Tuesday March 11, 2025, at 6:30PM at the North Rustico Lions Club on the proposed 2025-2026 operational and capital budgets for the Town, Sewer and Water Utility, Fire Department and Wellness Centre
- Council approved the boutiques sign on Harbourview Dr for new advertising signage.
- Council approved Book Keeper/Deputy CAO Sheri Prosser Dykstra to have full access and signing authority to all bank accounts at PCU and RBC and to CRA accounts for the Town, Fire Dept and Sewer and Water Utility.
- Council appointed Sharon McNeil as a member of the Wellness Centre Fundraising committee and further appointed Councillor Linda McFalls and Tracey Compton as members of the Planning Board.
- Council rescinded the resolution to retain the services of Karen Campbell of Cox & Palmer Law firm as an independent third party in an investigation of a pertinent HR matter due to time constraints.
- Council retained the services of Tory Kennedy of Monarch Consulting as an independent third party in an investigation of a pertinent HR matter.
- Council approved a Recreational Levy Resolution to be presented to the Federation of PEI Municipalities membership

Council Decisions March 2025

- Council approved CAO Stephanie Moase apply for Jobs for Youth Funding.
- Council approved Capital Investment Plan to extend the sewer and water lines to the end of Simon Dr.
- Council appointed Satyajit Sen as the interim development officer for the Town.
- Council provided preliminary approval to the Edgewater Estates subdivision application with conditions for final approval as listed on the permit by the development officer
- Council approved Mar 27th, 2025, 9am for the operational and capital budget approval meeting
- Council approved the Boardwalk increase in engineering services and project management for CBCL in the amount of \$9,600+HST.
- Council approved Change Order 01 Boardwalk Project for Diversified Divers in the amount of \$120,890+HST for new stairs and upgraded rest areas
- Based on legal advice, Council will remove specified signage with religious references.
- Council moved to no longer except any credit card payments due to rising costs.
