Council Decisions

- ✓ Council approved the Boardwalk Art Installation by Patrick Brunet for \$3000.
- ✓ Council approved the Gulf Shore Community Health Corporation to do a one-year trial of the Boardwalk Pumpkin Lane from Nov 1st to 9th inclusive with daily checking for clean-up.
- ✓ Council agreed to add Council of the Town of North Rustico to the letter to Minister Hadju.
- ✓ Council agreed to hire Belmont Metals to complete the HVAC at time and materials beginning with the upstairs kitchen not to exceed the maximum upset of \$180,000.
- ✓ Council approved the CAO to apply for EDA funding for staff person at the Wellness Centre and further approve the Mayor and CAO to sign agreements to complete this resolution.
- ✓ Council denied the request for a building extension for Lot 16 on Autumn Lane.
- ✓ Council appointed Rachel Cormier to the Recreation and Events committee.

Changes to Official Plan and Zoning and Subdivision Bylaw

Take notice that pursuant to the Planning Act and the Town of North Rustico's Official Plan and Zoning and Subdivision Bylaw, Council will hold a Public Meeting, Wednesday, November 5, 2025, at 7:00pm at the Eliyahu Wellness Centre 20 Recreation Street, North Rustico.

The purpose of the meeting is to allow residents and other interested persons an opportunity to review and make representation concerning the following amendments to the Town of North Rustico's Official Plan and Zoning & Subdivision Bylaw :

- To rezone a portion of PID# 237347 from (R2) Two Family Residential Zone to (R3) Multi Family Residential Zone
- To amend the Official Plan – Zoning Map to accommodate the above changes
