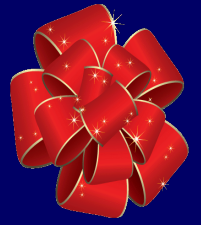

Assembly # 1867 Father George Belcourt

Five years ago, Father J D McNeill chapter 9026 started a project to honor Veterans from around our area that had passed away from WW1 to now and had served in the CAF in the past and up to the present. With the help also of the Assembly #1867 Father George Belcourt we started to build white crosses with the name of the Veterans on the crosses in alphabetical order with a poppy on each one of them. We started the project with around 150 and now sadly we have nearly 500. One week before Remembrance Day we put them in line at our town Cenotaph with the help of the KOC and with volunteers from the Mount School and members of Town Council. It is quite a beautiful sight and a beautiful tribute to the Veterans that serve our country in many conflicts all over the world. We owe a big Thank You to all that have served and now serving to keep our country free.

Lest We Forget

Council Decisions

- ❖ Council approved the CIP for funding through the Municipal Strategic Component in the amount of \$270,000 for the Simon Dr. Sewer & Water extension.
- ❖ Council approved the variance request for application 1747 Lot 16 Autumn Lane for the side yards to be 6.75ft instead of 7.5ft and a 2% increase in lot coverage.
- ❖ Council approved holding a Public Meeting at 7:00pm on Wednesday Nov 5, 2025, at the North Rustico Lions Club for a rezoning request for a portion of PID 237347 from R2 to R3.
- ❖ Council approved the 2024-2025 Audited Financial Statements as prepared by MRSB.

WINTER REMINDERS

Our sidewalk and various walkways through town, including the walkway at the cenotaph, walkways in Seawalk Park and the Boardwalk are not maintained during the winter months. The Town of North Rustico would also like to remind residents not to park on the side of the road or on the shoulder. Many of our streets are very narrow and this makes it difficult for snowploughs to clear snow. We thank you for your cooperation with this.
